MORNINGS

Mornings will be spent traipsing the grounds of the Rock Springs Ranch, in the Flint Hills with instructors, getting a hands-on feel for how the various critters and plants live together in the ecosystem we call Kansas.

AFTERNOON

Afternoons are then spent learning about several general interest areas of the Kansas outdoors- mammals, insects, birds, fish, amphibians and reptiles.

Is your fondest dream is to touch and hold a live snake?
Dreams come true at Outdoor Adventure Camp!

If snakes aren't exactly your thing, you will surely learn to identify the red-tailed hawk as he circles overhead, and you'll learn where to look for the underground trails of one of the hawk's prey- the prairie vole.

EVENINGS

Since the prairie doesn't go to sleep at sundown, neither will you. Depending on the evening, you may be out and about prowling for owls or spotlighting spiders. Another evening may be spent watching the bats gobble bugs. And yet another evening time will find you sitting around a campfire, listening to tales of Kansas folklore.

Rock Springs Ranch is the Kansas 4-H Conference Center. It is located 8 miles south of I-70 (Junction City) on US Highway 77, then West and South on Kansas Highway 157.

FROM KANSAS CITY

Take I-70 West. From the Exit of I-70 and US-77 (Exit 295) travel 8 miles South on US-77. Turn right onto K-157 Highway. Follow K-157 4 miles West and South to the entrance of Rock Springs Ranch.

FROM WICHITA

Take I-135 North. Take Exit 33 (North of Newton) to US-50, travel 26 miles North. At the junction of US-50 and US-77, take US-77 North past Herington to K-157 Highway. Turn left onto K-157 Highway. Follow K-157 4 miles West and South to the entrance of Rock Springs Ranch.
